

A quick change of scenery? This versatile bench can be used in more than one way. Take a seat on the bench or turn around to the opposite direction - the backrest now doubles as a tabletop. This design adds comfort to each street, rooftop, garden or balcony.

In 2021, the town of Rockford, Michigan closed part of its main street for a few months to create a public gathering space. After seeing how the main street quickly became a bustling place for families and friends, boosting the local businesses as well, the city has made a long-term investment in togetherness by placing Hopper benches along the walkways to bring people together in the public space.









Hopper bench



To create an attractive and lively urban area, Okayama city in Japan has placed 30 Hopper benches along the main street. By shifting from a 'car-centered' to a 'people-first' area, the city has created a spacious area that is fun to walk along. Now, people from all ages feel comfortable using the public space that has shifted from a parking space into a meeting area.





Hopper bench wood

In streetscapes and squares, gardens or balconies, Hopper bench suits any location. This multi-functional design can be used in more ways than a traditional city bench. The attached legs allow you to slide in from the sides and sit down with a backrest. And the top surface doubles as a tabletop when facing the opposite direction. 

Being based in the only hops region in Belgium, we've let the many hop gardens that dominate the landscape inspire our designs. Mimicking the hop fields, the Hopper shade has slanted poles that fold the canopy in an esthetically pleasing way.

In front of Japan's SAGA Arena, Hopper tables with Hopper shades line the bustling pedestrian deck, offering a welcoming spot to pause. Whether for coffee or lunch, these shaded tables turn every visit into a moment of discovery.







With the Hopper shade, you're safe: protected from the intense midday sun, sheltered from a passing rain shower, and cocooned in a warm glow during long summer evenings.







This garden in Grand Rapids, Michigan, USA, looks like a winter wonderland, straight from a fairytale.



Hopper shade

In the opened and closed positions, Hopper shade echoes the lines of the Hopper design. It opens and closes effortlessly, thanks to an internal spring mechanism that takes up no extra space beside the table. 
- Q: Do you need to oil the wood?
- A: Just like other types of wood, wood will gradually become rougher and start to turn grey as a consequence of exposure to the sun and rain. Small cracks and crevices can also appear as part of this process. We strongly advise everyone to treat the furniture with our Wood Protector. This 100% natural oil controls the moisture level within the wood, which makes the planks stay stable for longer, and the layer of oil also helps to prevent spilled liquids from being absorbed, so that stains tend to stay superficial. It is best to repeat this treatment at regular intervals.





Wood

- When delivered, the wood is untreated.
- Wood is a natural material and its look is different for every slat, plank and tree.
- Wood will gradually become rougher and start to turn grey as a consequence of exposure to the sun and rain. We recommend oiling the wood at regular intervals depending from location and general weather conditions.
- Clean regularly with mild detergent. Never use a high pressure cleaner as this will roughen the wood's smooth surface and irreparably damage the wood's fiber.
- Thorough cleaning with Extremis Wood Cleaner.
- We strongly recommend that you treat your wood with wood protector to protect it from stains - small cracks and crevices can also appear as part of this process. We strongly advise everyone to treat the furniture with our Wood Protector.

Galvanized steel

- Galvanization will become less shiny when used outdoors.
- Flame retarding NEN-EN13501-1 A1 Class A1

- products will not contribute to fire in any stage. including fully developed fire. For this reason, they are assumed to be capable of satisfying all requirements of all lower classes as well.
- Possible impurities in the immersion tank can cause black marks during galvanization, which are intrinsic to this industrial finishing technique.
- White marks on this zinc layer are also intrinsic to this procedure and will disappear when the furniture is put outdoors.
- This industrial finishing technique may result in a rougher surface. This is intrinsic to the process.

Powder coating

- White powder coating requires more maintenance.

Always make sure that no people or obstacles are situated close to the poles or between the shade and the table when opening the shade.
- Do not open & close the shade with your bare feet, always wear shoes.

- For small people the shade can be too heavy to open single-handedly by means of the leather strap. In case, open the shade together with another person. (1m70)
- Do not use torches, candles, bbq's, etc under the shade.

High-tech polyester

- Shake or brush off loose dirt immediately.
- Do not use any aggressive detergents as they will remove the protective coating of the fabric.
- We strongly advise you not to use a high-pressure hose for cleaning.
